- Numbers above denote the number of countries.
- Visa free means you do not need a visa nor do you need to pay for entering the country.
- Visa on Arrival means you get a visa on arrival in the country on paying a fee.
- Unlimited access means you can land, reside and work without a visa or permit or charges.

- ❖ On a Portuguese Passport you get to enter the US, UK, Australia, New Zealand, Canada, Brazil, South Africa, Turkey, Singapore, Japan and South Korea without even obtaining a visa for social / visit purpose.
- ❖ You can Work and reside anywhere in the EU on a Portuguese passport
- ❖ After getting a Portuguese Passport You can still reside, work and live in India permanently (on an OCI) and enjoy all rights of a citizen and financial rights of a NRI, you will however not be able to Contest Elections or Vote and you will be barred from Purchasing Agriculture land however you can inherit it or it can be gifted to you.
- ❖ Your employment and business opportunities go to the first world (EU) unhindered without the need for Visa's and work permits.
- ❖ Your children can also opt for Portuguese Citizenship / Nationality once you have obtained it.
